Mr. Olsheski was a member of the trial team that represented Cisco against plaintiff Egenera, Inc. in a patent infringement jury trial. The team achieved a complete non-infringement defense verdict for Cisco. At trial, Mr. Olsheski conducted the direct examination of Cisco's damages expert.

Mr. Olsheski was also a member of the trial team defending antitrust claims brought by Arista Networks against Cisco. He prepared witnesses for trial, and took the trial deposition of a key witness. The morning of trial, Arista agreed to drop its antitrust claims and pay Cisco a substantial settlement.

During law school, Mr. Olsheski was an associate articles editor of the Georgia State University Law Review, and received the ABA-BNA Award for Excellence In the Study of Intellectual Property. Before law school, Mr. Olsheski worked as an engineer.
